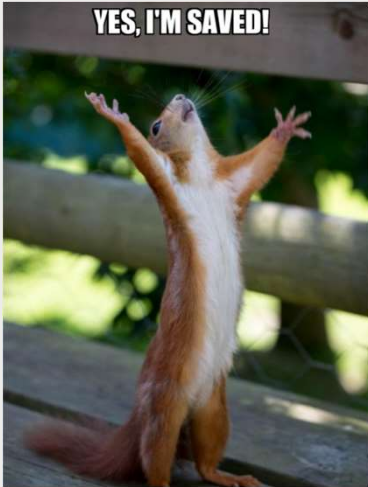

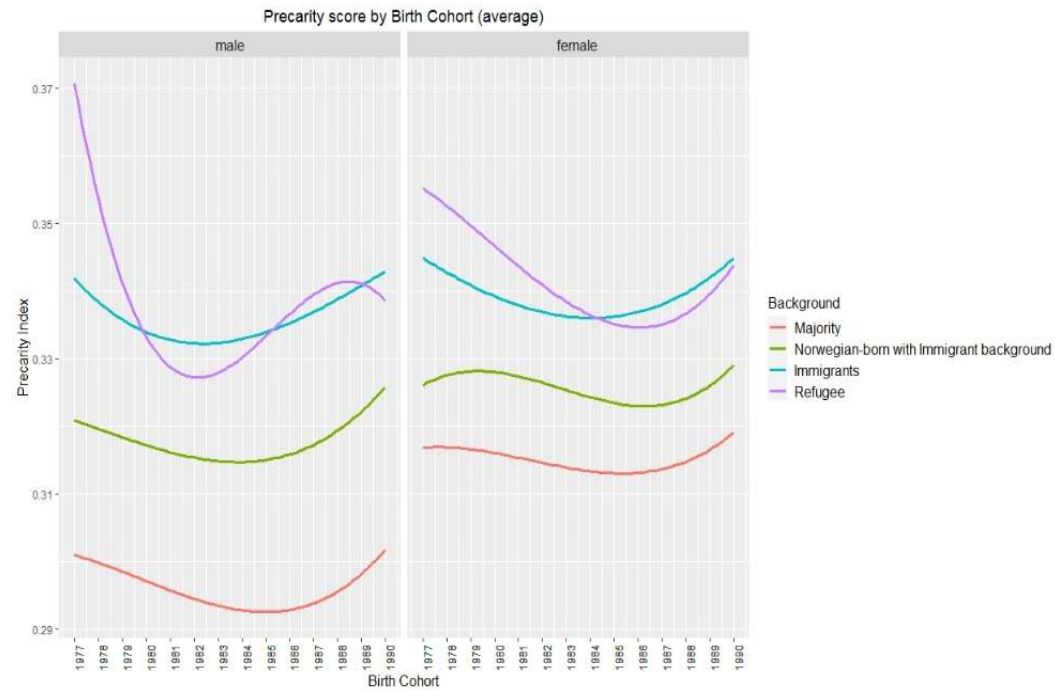
- Institutional knowledge on the application process was not consolidated
- Project needed to connect different register (different applications for some of the registers we were using)



- Redoing an analysis I did...
- Outcome
  - Income from work (*yrkesinntekter* i G)
- Control variables
  - Assigned gender at birth
  - Family SES (constructed)
  - Immigrant/Country background
  - Level of Centrality

Using NAV's basic amount in the National Insurance Scheme "G" (*Grunnbeløp*) with Occupational income (*Yrkesinntekter*) to measure labor market attachment:

- **NEET**: income from work < 0.5 G, and not in Education
- **Student**: income from work < 3.5 G and enrolled in Education
- **Unstable**: < 3.5 G & >= 0.5 G
- **Core Labor** >= 3.5 G
- **High Core** >= 5.0 G
