### Table of Contents (TOC) Alerts by RSS or Email

Any individual is able to set up an RSS or email alert when a new *Table of Contents* for a particular publication within the *ACM Digital Library* is made available. To do so a person must have an *ACM Web Account*. *ACM Web Accounts* are free and easy to set up. To create a *Web Account* click on the "SIGN UP" link which can be found on the upper right hand corner of any page within the Digital Library.

#### AutoAlert

Creates a search that runs automatically on a regular basis and emails results to a designated list of recipients.

Searches developed in the Books@Ovid database cannot be saved as AutoAlerts.

#### Expert Searches

Searches about specific topics are made available to multiple users at a site. Expert Searches allow colleagues of the same group account to share search strategies.
